CPR & First Aid certification program

The Oregon Home Care Commission (OHCC) offers a CPR & First Aid certification program to homecare workers, personal support workers and personal care attendants. Upon completion of the course, the provider will earn a 2-year certificate and may apply for a renewal certification, when the initial certification is expiring. The CPR & First Aid Certification program is voluntary and is not part of the provider's credentialing. All OHCC certifications require a CPR & First Aid Certification with a skills assessment.

Provider must:

- have an active provider number.
- complete a registration through OHCC's Learning Management System.
- complete the CPR & First Aid certification within a 6-months from the time they are notified by OHCC with approval to begin the course.

Program requirements

- There is no stipend payment for attending the CPR & First Aid certification course.
- A new course request will be required if the provider fails to start their course within 6-month of receiving the course registration information from OHCC.
- Providers participating in OHCC's virtual two-part CPR & First Aid course will be required to have both parts completed within 60 days of the start date.
- Eligible providers are referred to different training sites, and each have their own cancelation policy. It is the responsibility of the provider to know what the cancelation policy is, at the time of registration. Cancelation is allowed if it is following the training site's cancelation policy timelines.
- When the provider does not attend the class that they are registered for, and they did not follow the cancelation policy; OHCC will not re-approve

or pay for a CPR & First Aid course until the next renewal cycle, which will be in 2-years.

- All OHCC CPR & First Aid certification courses must be pre-approved by OHCC.
- All Instructors, that will be invoicing OHCC for training providers, must be pre-approved for each individual provider.
- Instructors will not be reimbursed for training a provider without pre-approval.
- All OHCC sponsored CPR & First Aid courses will require a demonstration of CPR skills and a training assessment.
- OHCC will not reimburse any providers who pay out of pocket for a course.
