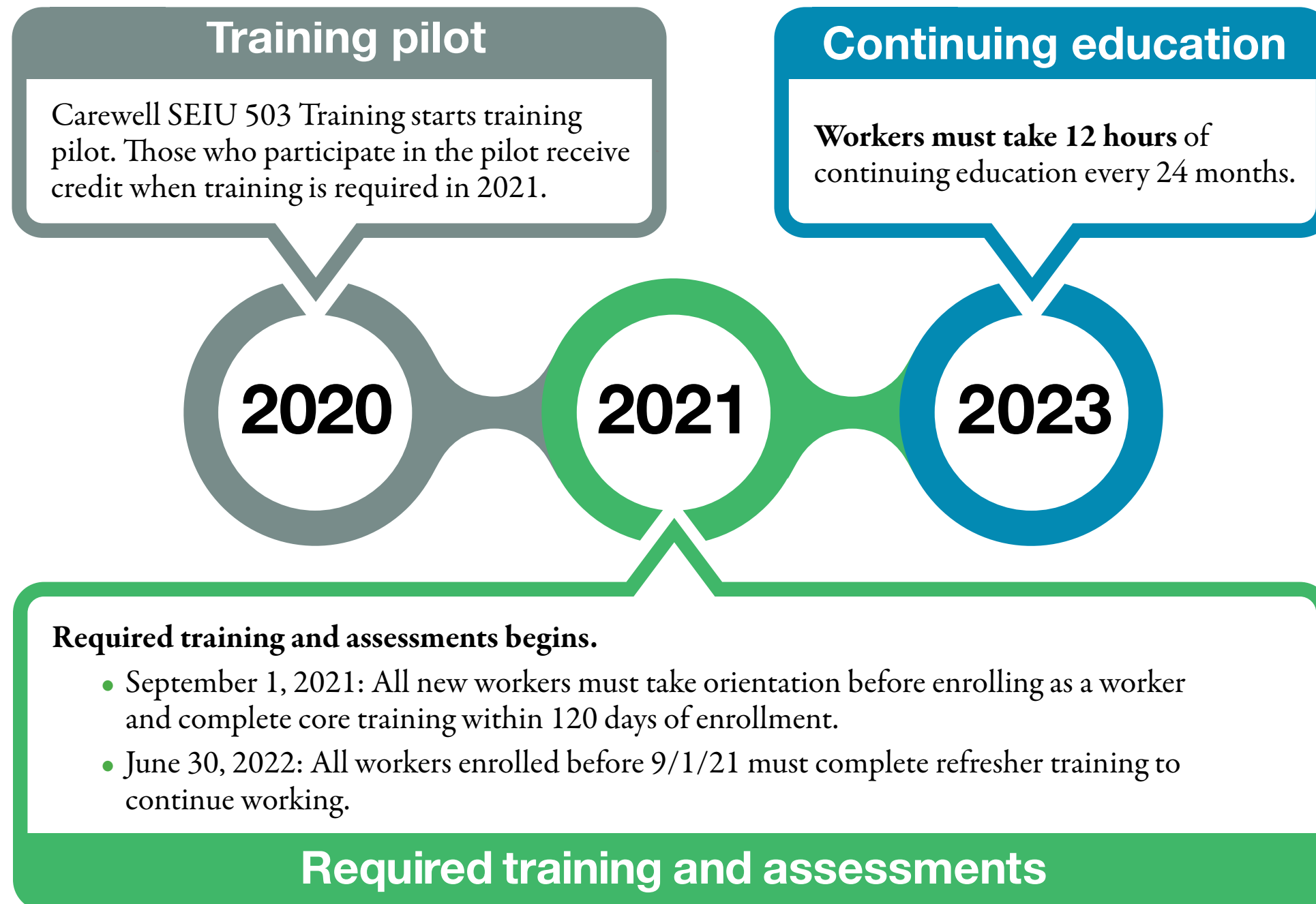


# Timeline for required homecare and personal support worker training



The Oregon Home Care Commission ensures high quality homecare services for older adults and people with disabilities. Homecare and personal support workers, including personal care attendants, provide homecare services. These workers help older adults and persons with disabilities live in their homes and communities safely and independently.



# Required training topics

## Workers must take:

- **Orientation**
- **Core training**
- **Continuing education**
- **Refresher training** (workers enrolled before 9/1/2021)
