

# COVID-19 Home Tests for OHP Members

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## **OHP covers COVID-19 at-home tests.**

The Oregon Health Plan (OHP) covers COVID-19 at-home tests for OHP and CWM members.

- OHP and CWM members who have signs of COVID-19 or have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 can get COVID-19 at-home tests.
- The COVID-19 at-home tests do not replace COVID-19 testing done in clinics and labs.

The Oregon Health Authority strongly suggests members talk to their doctor if they have signs of COVID-19 or may have been exposed.

## **OHP and CWM members can get up to 8 COVID-19 at-home tests per month without a doctor's order.**

To get more than eight tests in a month, OHP and CWM members would need to get a doctor's order.

- Please contact your primary care provider (PCP) if you need more than eight at-home tests per month.

## **All types of COVID-19 at-home tests are covered.**

OHP covers all COVID-19 at-home tests that are approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), including COVID-19 home tests that require an internet connection or smartphone to read the results.

## **Pick up COVID-19 at-home tests at a pharmacy or retail store.**

Members should bring the COVID-19 at-home test to the pharmacy counter to check out and let the pharmacy know they are an OHP or CWM member. Members will not be charged for COVID-19 at-home tests.

- Due to limited supplies, not all pharmacies or retail stores may have COVID-19 at-home tests. Members may want to call the pharmacy or retail store to ask if COVID-19 home tests are in stock.
- OHP covers at-home tests picked up at the pharmacy counter, not tests brought online.

## **Can't find home tests at your pharmacy?**

Ask your provider if they carry home test kits. OHP now allows these providers to bill for kits they give to fee-for-service members:

- Clinics
- Hospitals
- Federally Qualified Health Centers
- Home health agencies
- Independent laboratories
- Indian Health Service facilities
- Opioid treatment programs
- Physicians and other practitioners
- Rural health clinics
- Skilled nursing facilities
