More people eligible for help

As of **July 1, 2022**, more people are eligible for full Oregon Health Plan (OHP) benefits and Office of Developmental Disabilities Services (ODDS) supports and services **regardless of immigration status.**

Who is eligible?

ODDS services

- **All people** who meet I/DD eligibility can get case management services
- People **19-25** or **55 and older** who meet income and eligibility requirements can also access ODDS services and supports:
 - Home and community-based services like help with bathing, dressing, eating, transportation and more
 - Employment services
 - Assistive technology
