Enhanced Exposure Testing

A 5-Step Process for Parents and Families

1. The family has provided consent for optional COVID-19 testing.
2. The school notifies you that a case of COVID-19 has been identified in your child's school group that includes a medically complex individual, or an individual at increased risk of severe disease.
3. Your child is tested for COVID-19 at the school testing site.
4. If COVID-19 test results are:
 - Positive - your child must immediately isolate at home
 - Negative - your child may continue to attend school.
5. Testing may occur at any time within 10 days of their exposure.

"Enhanced exposure testing" applies to K-12 exposures in cohorts which include individuals at increased risk of severe disease (e.g., individuals with underlying medical conditions or immunocompromised status, individuals age 65 and older, and those who live with individuals at increased risk)
