

# Citizenship Waived Medical (CWM) and COVID-19

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## CWM members have coverage for COVID-19.

Do you have CWM and need testing for COVID-19? You're covered! Do you need to stay in the hospital because of COVID-19? You're covered for that too.

During the national COVID-19 emergency, CWM covers vaccines, testing, and treatment for COVID-19. This is true even if you don't get care in an emergency room. CWM still covers you, even if you test negative for COVID-19.

## What is CWM?

CWM is emergency-only coverage. It covers emergency room care and ambulance rides.

CWM is for people who:

- Meet income and other criteria,
- Are 26 through 54 years old, and
- Do not qualify for full Oregon Health Plan (OHP) benefits due to their immigration status.

People who are under 26 who do not meet the immigration status requirements qualify for full OHP through [Healthier Oregon](#).

## CWM Plus coverage for pregnancy

CWM Plus:

- Is for people who are pregnant and not eligible for full OHP benefits because of their immigration status.
- Has the same benefits as full OHP.
- Covers COVID-19 vaccines, testing and treatment, even in a hospital.

Information for CWM Members

CWM Plus coverage will not end during the national COVID-19 emergency. Benefits will not change back to emergency-only coverage until the COVID-19 national emergency ends.
