This Reopening Guidance Tool is intended to be a visual way to see, in one place, what sectors and activities are generally permitted in baseline, phase one and phase two of Oregon's reopening during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Reopening Guidance Tool may not include every activity or business and cannot be relied upon to determine whether a specific activity or business is permitted in the state, or what guidance applies. The Reopening Guidance Tool will be updated often to adapt to changes in the state.
