

Where can I get my COVID-19 vaccine?




-  **Mass vaccination clinics**, such as the Oregon Convention Center and similar sites in Deschutes, Jackson, Lane, Benton and Marion counties.
-  **Local public health authorities**, who work with local providers, including some **hospitals and health clinics**, to get shots in arms.
-  **Pharmacies**. Right now, some Costco, Health Mart brand pharmacies, Safeway/Albertson's, and Walgreens locations are offering COVID vaccines. More pharmacies will join as more vaccines become available.
-  **Federally Qualified Health Centers (also called Community Health Centers)**, which have over 270 sites across the state.
-  **Mobile clinics** for specific at-risk populations (for example, home-bound seniors or people with developmental disabilities).
-  **Tribal health authorities** for tribal members and their families.
-  **Veteran's Administration health providers** for service members receiving care through the VA.
