








Where can I get my COVID-19 vaccine?




-  **Search for vaccines near you at** <https://getvaccinated.oregon.gov/#/locator>
-  **Local public health authorities**, who work with local providers, including some **hospitals and health clinics**, to get shots in arms.
-  **Pharmacies**. Local pharmacies and national pharmacy chains offer COVID-19 vaccines.
-  **Federally Qualified Health Centers (also called Community Health Centers)**, which have over 270 sites across the state.
-  **Mobile clinics** for specific at-risk populations.
-  **Tribal health authorities** for tribal members and their families.
-  **Veteran's Administration health providers** for service members receiving care through the VA.
