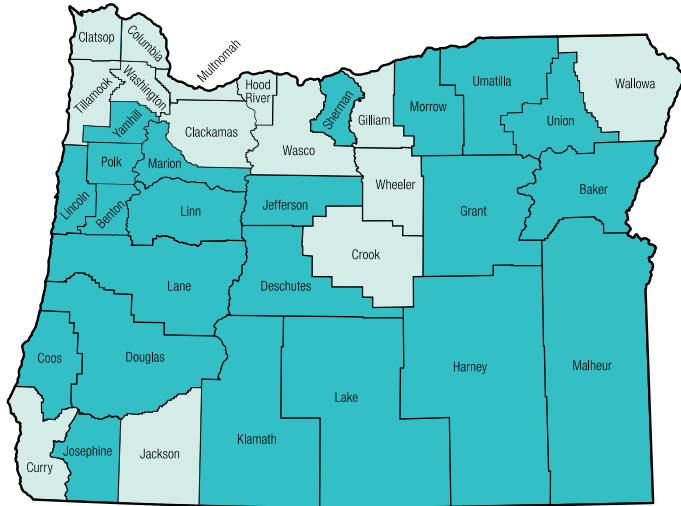
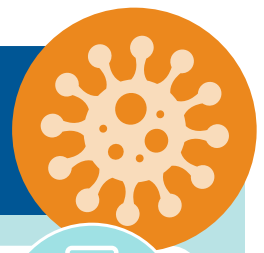


Counties Expanding Vaccinations



Twenty-two Oregon counties have submitted attestation letters signaling their intention to immediately offer COVID-19 vaccinations to expanded eligibility groups.

The counties are Baker, Benton, Coos, Deschutes, Douglas, Grant, Harney, Jefferson, Josephine, Klamath, Lake, Lane, Lincoln, Linn, Malheur, Marion, Morrow, Polk, Sherman, Umatilla, Union and Yamhill.

These counties can now vaccinate all individuals listed in [Phase 1B, Group 6](#), ahead of the designated statewide start date of March 29.

Group 6 is comprised of:



Adults ages 45 to 64 with one or more underlying condition with increased risk.



Migrant and seasonal farm workers



Seafood and agricultural workers



Food processing workers



People living in low-income, senior congregate and independent living facilities



Sheltered and unsheltered individuals experiencing homelessness



People displaced by wildfires



Wildland firefighters



Pregnant people 16 and over
