

How Can Counties Move to Lower Risk?

Route 1

- ✓ **Vaccinate 65%** of residents 16 and older against COVID-19 with at least one dose
- AND**
- ✓ have an **equity plan reviewed and accepted by Oregon Health Authority.**

Permanent move.

Route 2

- ✓ Meet low infection rates set by the Governor's office.*



If rates of COVID-19 rise, county may return to more restrictive risk levels.

Lower Risk Counties#



Increase capacity limits for

- **Indoor dining**
- **Indoor entertainment**
- **Gyms**

Expand business hours

Allow limited work in the office

(Areas where only fully vaccinated people are allowed do not count toward capacity limits.)
