

## **The Law**

- Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1965 and Section 1557 of the Affordable Care Act require all federally funded agencies to provide free language access services.
- American with Disabilities Act requires all places of public accommodation to ensure that communications with individuals with disabilities are as effective as communications with everyone else.
